



## **SPECIALIST IN LAND CONDITION TRAINING DAY**

As part of the development of the SiLC Registration scheme, members of the SiLC Professional and Technical Panel and Assessor Panel, are hosting a training day to provide information about the SiLC assessment process and the completion and use of the Land Condition Record on which the scheme is based. The training day is open to all those who are considering applying to become a SiLC. **A SiLC applicant must have a minimum of 8 years post-graduate work in Land Condition and membership of a suitable Professional Body at an appropriate level (the Registration Guide available on the SiLC website gives more detailed information).**

The day will be hosted by a member of the SiLC Professional and Technical Panel (PTP) and by member/s of the SiLC Assessors Panel, it will be held on Thursday November 30th 2006 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Central Square, Birmingham B1 1HH. Registration will be at 9.15 to 9.30 am. Please book early to ensure a place, numbers are limited and will be allocated in order of application.
