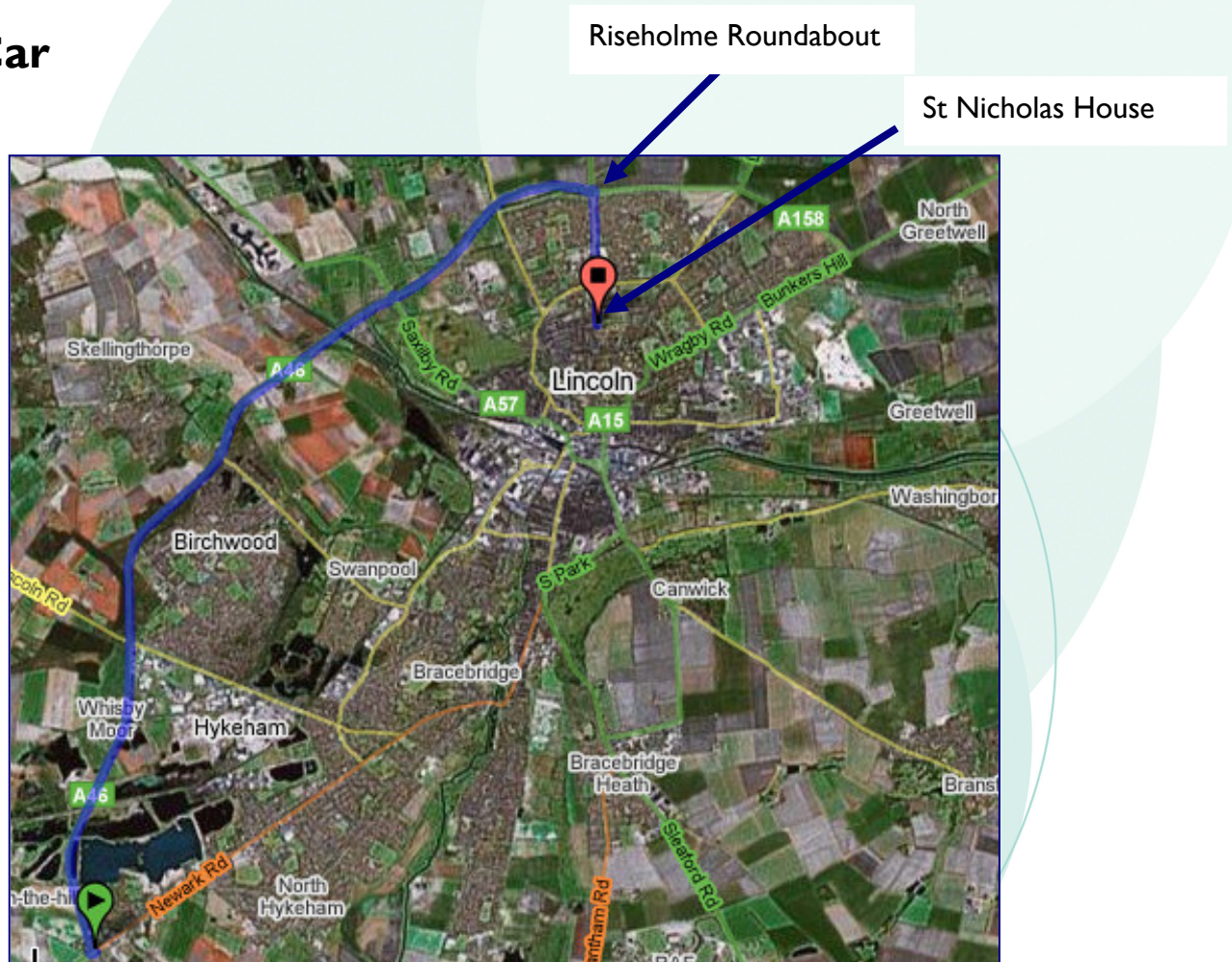


Directions to St Nicholas House, Lincoln HQ of the IEEMA

St Nicholas House is situated in the North up-hill area of Lincoln, just past the Bailgate.

By Car



From the A46

If you are traveling to Lincoln from the South, head for the A46. Travel along the A46 until you reach the Riseholme Roundabout (junction with the A15). Turn right (third exit) at the roundabout and continue past the Yarborough Leisure Centre until you reach another roundabout. Continue straight over the roundabout (second exit) onto Newport and St Nicholas House is 200 yards on the left hand side, immediately off St John's Road.

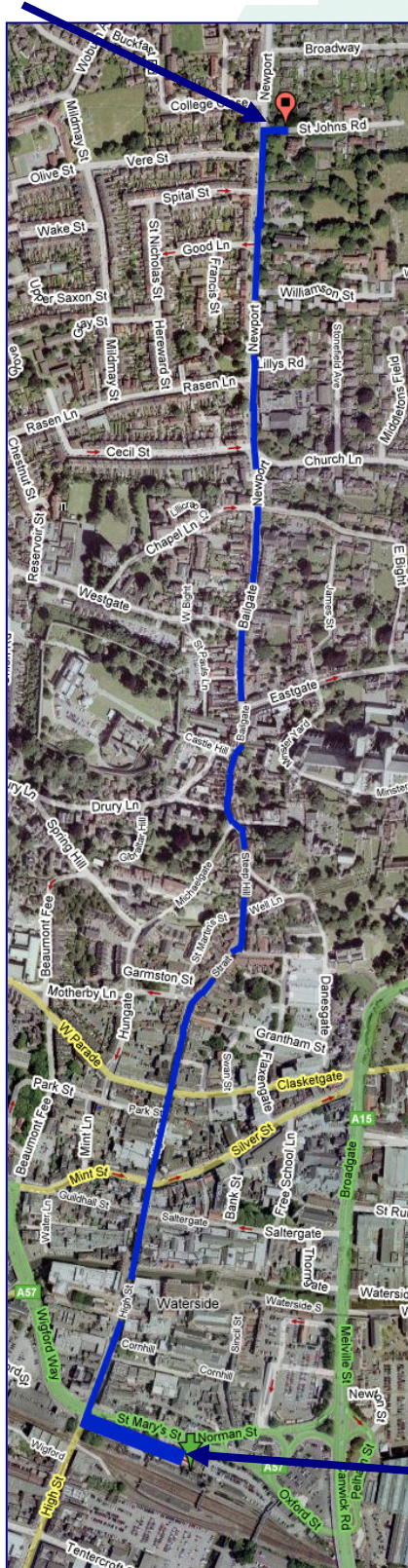
From the A15

If you are approaching Lincoln from the North, travel down the A15 southbound until you reach a Riseholme Roundabout on the A46 (Lincoln bypass). Continue straight over the roundabout (second exit) and continue past the Yarborough Leisure Centre until you reach another roundabout. Continue straight over the roundabout (second exit) onto Newport and St Nicholas House is 200 yards on the left hand side, immediately off St John's Road.

By Train

Lincoln Central Train Station is approximately 1 mile from St Nicholas House and is located in the city centre. Lincoln Central Station can be reached from the South or North-East via the GNER Main Line from Newark and from the Midlands via Birmingham and Nottingham on the Central Trains network. There is a taxi rank immediately outside the station and a typical taxi fare to our offices costs around £3.00.

On Foot (from the City Centre)

To get to St Nicholas House on foot from the station, exit the station and turn left. Continue until the St Mary's Street crossing and cross over the road towards the pedestrianised area of the High Street. Continue up the High Street for approximately half a mile through the Stonebow and up towards Steep Hill. At the top of the High Street take the right-hand fork past Kind bar onto The Strait and continue up the hill onto Steep Hill. Walk onwards onto Castle Square through to Bailgate, through Newport Arch and onto Newport. Continue forward onto Newport and St Nicholas House is located approximately 700 yards on the right hand side. Access the grounds by turning into St John's Road. It takes around 20-25 minutes to walk to St Nicholas House from the City Centre but the walk involves a very steep hill.
