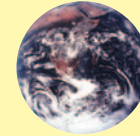

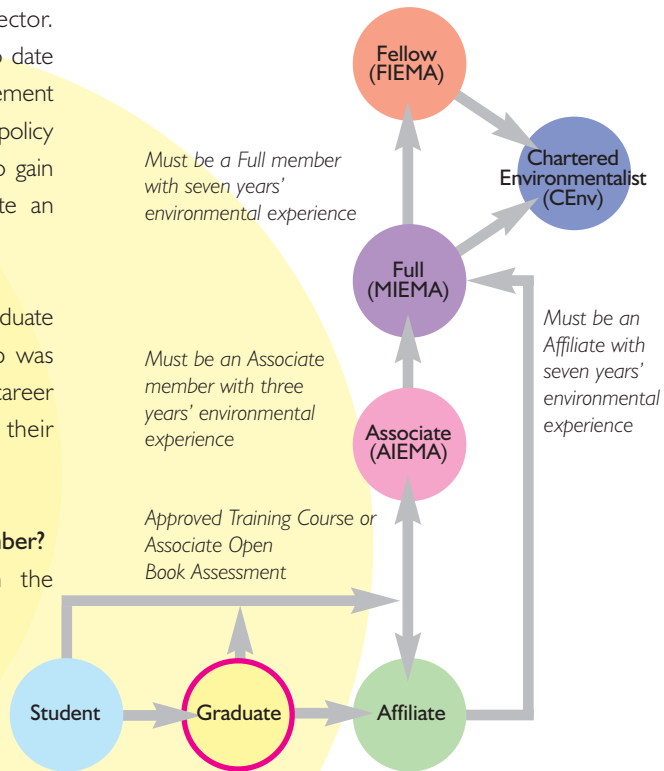
In a recent survey, 92% of IEMA Graduate members stated that their membership was important in supporting their personal career development and enhancing their professional status.

available at a discounted rate. After the initial two year period Graduate members will be upgraded to Affiliate member. Typically, Graduate members undertake the Associate Open Book Assessment within two years.
