

## **ES/ET Awards**

The IEMA is again sponsoring the ES Environmental Manager of Year Award (now named **Environmental Services Award**), which is now in its second year. The IEMA will also be sponsoring the inaugural ET Innovation for Technology Award.

The ES Environmental Manager of Year Award 2007, sponsored by the IEMA, will be presented at a Gala Dinner, to be held on **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2007**. This award is now in its second year, with Brian Lewis of Bombardier Aerospace in Belfast winning the 2006 award.

The award will recognise an individual's effort in promoting best environmental practice, enhancing the environmental performance of an organisation or developing an innovative solution to an environmental problem. The award is open to all individuals that have an environmental responsibility as part of their job title, and who are based in the UK and Republic of Ireland. Both IEMA members and non members are welcome to submit an entry.

The winning candidate will be able to demonstrate how they have enhanced the environmental performance of an organisation, for example by:

- *Quantifiable environmental performance improvements;*
- *Promoting best practice to achieve a positive environmental impact;*
- *Introducing an innovative solution to an environmental problem; or*
- *Delivering environmental improvement in a challenging environment*

The Innovation for Technology Award will reflect an innovative product or service that can demonstrably offer significant environmental benefits either as a function of the use of the product or in its design and manufacture.

The winning candidate for this award will need to show examples of:

- *Environmental benefits of the use of the product*
- *Environmental advantages over competitor or 'standard' products*
- *Demonstrable consideration of the environment in the design of the product.*
  - *Minimisation of the use of resources*
  - *Innovative use of reused or recycled materials*
  - *Reuse or recyclability of the product*
  - *Cost effectiveness*

IEMA Chief Executive Russell Foster, Anya Ledwith, the Environmental Manager at Crawley Borough Council, and Tom Idle, Editor of Environment Business, will again form the panel of judges that assess the submissions for both awards.
