

## TOP GREEN AWARDS DEADLINE EXTENDED!

**The closing date for applications for two prestigious environmental awards has been extended to allow entrants more time to prepare their applications.**

The IEMA, (Institute of Environmental Management and Assessment), is working with Faversham House and SustainabilityLive! on the Environmental Technology (ET) Innovation and Environmental Services (ES) Environmental Manager of The Year awards.

The deadline for the IEMA to receive applications was due to be at the end of February. But as it takes some time to successfully plan and prepare a worthwhile application for these awards, the IEMA and Faversham House have decided to extend the closing date by an entire month.

Therefore, Environmental Managers and environmental innovators now have until **Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> March** to submit their applications. The judges, chaired by IEMA Chief Executive Russell Foster, are also keen to receive applications from colleagues of outstanding Environmental Managers who would like to submit an entry on their behalf as this method proved successful last year. Russell Foster also announced that, as he did last year, he will be offering **one year's free membership to the winner of each category.**
