The results of the IEMA Environmental Practitioner's Salary Survey results will be launched this coming Monday!

These anticipated results from the IEMA (Institute of Environmental Management & Assessment) survey will be announced to profile how far the environmental profession has progressed since 2005 when a similar survey was carried out.

The in-depth survey was administered by ERS Market Research amongst the IEMA's 10,300* UK Graduate, Affiliate, Associate, Full and Fellow members in May of this year and covers the essential areas of an environmentalists work and personal profile including;

- Age
- Mean earnings
- Bonuses
- Chartered status
- Levels of responsibility
- Education, training and Continuing Professional Development (CPD)
- Areas of work
- Employment sectors
- Perceptions of the profession
- Personal environmental behaviour

Now that the environment is a hot topic in terms of both government policy and the media, and that "green is the new black" in the terms of public awareness, these results could not come at a more significant time.

Chief Executive of the IEMA Russell Foster says *"This is the second major Membership survey that our very significantly placed and ever growing Institute has undertaken in the past few years.*

"As no other Institute in our field undertakes a survey of its members of this magnitude and at a time when the environment – through the Climate Change debate – is on everybody's lips, the timing and findings of such a survey could not have been more relevant. Our Institute will be using these findings to emphasise certain crucial messages to influential and important stakeholders such as Government and regulators."
